

Duty of Members

The purpose of this volunteer organization is to provide emergency support, assistance, community service, and search and rescue as directed by the Sheriff of Gem County. In order to fulfill our purpose it shall be the duty of every member of the Gem County Sheriff's Posse (GCSP) to make every effort to be available when called out for an emergency, participate in the training needed to keep themselves prepared, and to conduct themselves at all times in a professional manner.

All members eligible for call outs shall carry a current CPR and First Aid card and shall have completed the necessary training needed for an emergency response or be teamed with a trained member before they can be called to the field for an emergency. Training will be provided and/or organized by the GCSP. Members must remain current with training by participation in an adequate number of GCSP training sessions as determined by the Executive Committee.

It is important for members to remember the GCSP is an arm of the Gem County Sheriff's office and that our actions while in or out of uniform will reflect upon both organizations as well their oath of office.

Members hereby agree that upon termination membership in accordance with the By Laws that he/she will turn over all GCSP equipment (including badges) and the Sheriff's Office issued ID card.
